## Swimming Requirements

It is a National Curriculum requirement that at the end of Year 6 pupils should be taught to:

- swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of at least 25 metres
- use a range of strokes effectively [for example, front crawl, backstroke and breaststroke]
- perform safe self-rescue in different water-based situations

St Paul's Peel C.E. Primary School attends Worsley Leisure Centre for weekly swimming lessons led by fully qualified ASA instructors.

All year 3 and year 4 pupils attend weekly sessions over the course of the academic year in 10 week blocks of an hour lesson.
