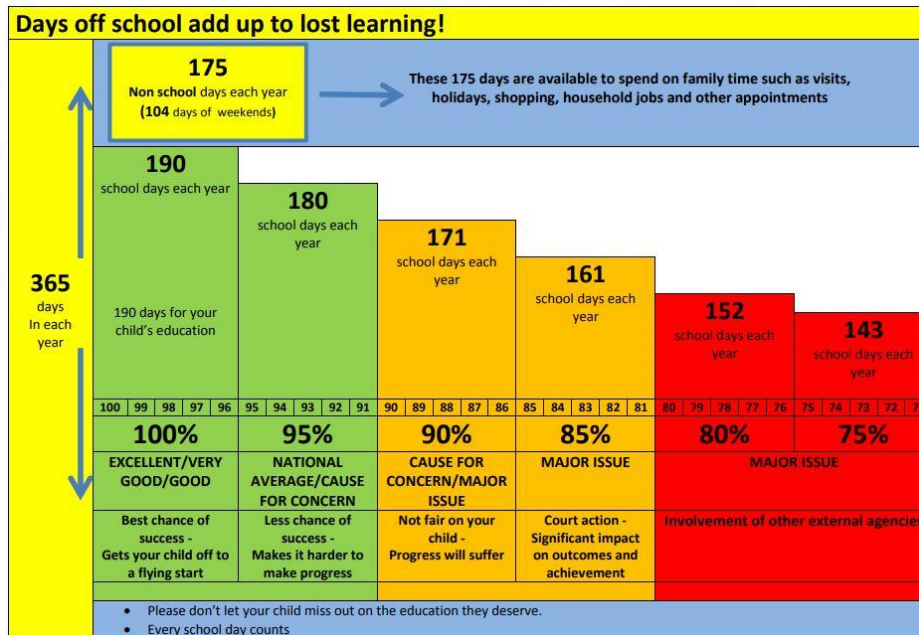
Mrs Williams - Assistant Headteacher

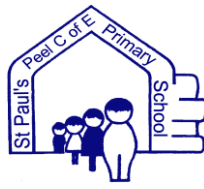
School Attendance:

Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 pupils receive universal free school meals (different to free school meals) so it is important that parents/carers for those pupils go to the above website to check eligibility for free school meals.

Free School Meal Vouchers - Summer Holidays:

The Household Support Fund is still continuing so the Local Authority will be providing funding to support with food and cost of living increase for children eligible for Free School Meals (benefit related) for the Summer Holidays. This will be £90.00 per child. You will again receive E- Vouchers direct to your email, prior to the holidays. Please let the school office know if you have a new email address.

The Local Authority agreed cut of date for families to register for FSM and receive vouchers for the summer holidays is Friday 12th July 2024.
