

Mathematics in Year 1

During the Autumn term Year 1 children will be focusing on number and place value to develop their basic number skills. These are the four areas we will be exploring this term:

- Number, place Value, counting in 10's and number bonds to 10

You can help your child by;

- * Asking them to count to 100 forward and backwards.
- * Counting in 10s.
- * Asking, what number comes before and after a given number.

English in Year 1

We have begun the Autumn term by reading *Brown bear, brown bear what can you see?* The children have enjoyed repeating the story in verse and making puppets of the characters to retell the story by role play. We will also be focusing on the reading of different narratives and our understanding of the text. In year 1 we begin to look at where a capital letter belongs, when to use a full stop and why we use question marks and exclamation marks.
