YEAR 6



English:

This half term our English work will be centred around 'The Nowhere Emporium' by Ross Mackenzie. A text filled with suspense, mystery and magic...*A mysterious ship from nowhere can appear at any time, in any city. Its' magical labyrinth of rooms contains wonders beyond belief. But to enter you must pay a price.* We will be focusing on this narrative genre to develop skills of describing setting; building up atmosphere and tension; introducing and developing characters and using dialogue to move the story on or reveal new information. In our reading we will be discussing the decisions authors make to impact and affect the reader. Throughout this unit, we will concentrate on varying sentence structures to achieve a particular effect and using a range of punctuation in our writing.

Science:

This half term we will be learning about Electricity and building on the skills, knowledge and understanding we learnt in Year 4.

History:

Our History work will focus on the Viking and Anglo-Saxon struggle for the kingdom of England to the time of Edward the Confessor.

RE:

As we prepare to celebrate Christmas we will be looking at the different ways this is celebrated in Christian countries around the world.

Maths:

This half term we will be developing our knowledge of fractions by learning how to add, subtract multiply and divide them. We will also compare, order and simplify fractions.

In Geometry, we will be plotting co-ordinates in all four quadrants. We will also be using formula to work out the area of triangles and parallelograms.

Our regular practise of TT Rockstars will keep the children's knowledge of times tables fresh. Whilst a trial of a new programme called 'Numbots' will help consolidate their knowledge of number.

Art/DT:

We will be creating our own silhouette artwork to commemorate Remembrance Day and then it's time to get cooking in Year 6!
