Contact Details:

Coronavirus:

The Government has altered some procedures that I wanted to highlight to you:

- If anyone has been in contact with a positive case daily Lateral Flow Device (LFD tests) need to be done for 7 days (Children 4 and under are exempt from this)
- If anyone tests positive for COVID the isolation period can be reduced from 10 days to 7 days providing that an LFD test is taken from 6 days after the day the symptoms started (or the day the test was taken if there weren't any symptoms), and another LFD test on the following day. The second LFD test should be taken at least 24 hours later. If both these test results are negative, and the person does not have a high temperature, the self-isolation can end after the second negative test result
