#### Green

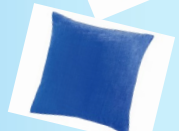
Be with all those who are sick – comfort and bless them and their families and protect the medical staff and care workers who look after them.

**Show us the good that can come out of the bad. Let us choose hope. Amen.**

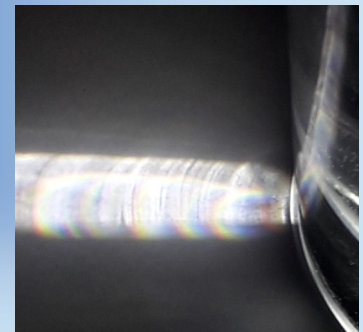
## **Activity 1 ≈ Make a Rainbow**

In the Bible, at the end of the story about Noah and the ark, we hear how God put a beautiful rainbow in the sky as a sign of his promise of hope to all the earth. If you haven't made one for the windows yet, why not give it a try?



## **Activity 2 ≈ Create a rainbow of your own.**

1. Fill the glass with water.
2. Cut a narrow rectangle in the middle of one piece of paper.
3. Stick that paper to the outside of the glass so that the slit is at the centre.
4. Place the another piece of paper on the floor on the other side of the glass to catch the rainbow, in a dark space.
5. Point a torch at the slit in the paper.
6. Start from the glass and slowly move the torch further and further from the glass.
7. Adjust the distance and angle of the torch until you see a rainbow on the paper on the other side.
